- More than 550 children in Great Falls are homeless at some point during the year
- More than 600 children are currently in foster care in Cascade County
- Within 18 months of aging out of foster care, 40-50% of foster youth become homeless
- Nearly 1/4 of high school students in Cascade County reported seriously considering attempting suicide in the past 12 months
- Many of the social services offered to children phase out between the ages of 14-18, leaving a large coverage gap in services for teenagers
